Areas within this section are reserved for both denominational and non-denominational burials.



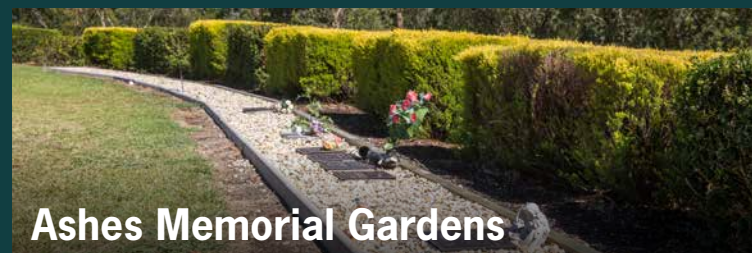
### Memorial Garden
